



Key Instant Recall Facts

Year 3 Autumn Term 2

KIRF: I know all number bonds to 100- any number.

Key Vocabulary:

- 25 add 75 equals 100
- 55 plus 45 is the same as 100 100 take away 6 equals 94
- 100 subtract 37 makes 63
- The difference between 91 and 100 is 9

By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts instantly

The children should know number bonds to 100. Some of these many include:

$$60 + 40 = 100$$

$$40 + 60 = 100$$

$$100 - 40 = 60$$

$$100 - 60 = 40$$

$$75 + 25 = 100$$

$$25 + 75 = 100$$

$$100 - 25 = 75$$

$$100 - 75 = 25$$

$$37 + 63 = 100$$

$$63 + 37 = 100$$

$$100 - 63 = 37$$

$$100 - 37 = 63$$

$$48 + 52 = 100$$

$$52 + 48 = 100$$

$$100 - 48 = 52$$

$$100 - 52 = 48$$
