KIRF: I know all number bonds to 1000- any number.

By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts instantly

The children should know number bonds to 1000. Some of these many include:

$$600 + 400 = 1000$$

$$400 + 600 = 1000$$

$$1000 - 400 = 600$$

$$1000 - 600 = 400$$

$$750 + 250 = 1000$$

$$250 + 750 = 1000$$

$$1000 - 250 = 750$$

$$1000 - 750 = 250$$

$$370 + 630 = 1000$$

$$630 + 370 = 1000$$

$$1000 - 630 = 370$$

$$1000 - 370 = 630$$

$$480 + 520 = 1000$$

$$520 + 480 = 1000$$

$$1000 - 480 = 520$$

$$1000 - 520 = 480$$

Key Vocabulary:

- 250 add 750 equals 1000
- 550 plus 450 is the same as 1000
- 1000 take away 60 equals 940
- 1000 subtract 370 makes 630
- The difference between 910 and 1000 is 90

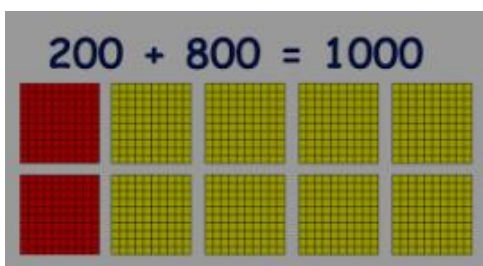
What do we need to add to 700 to make 1000?

If I have 360, how many more do I need to get to 1000?

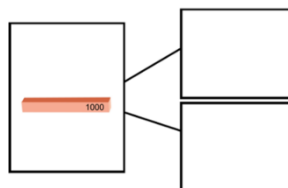
What is the difference between 1000 and 740?
